3. REMOVE YOUR DRIVE WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED AND YOUR VIDEO IS SAVED




03 What is the One button studio?

THE OBS IS AN AUTOMATED VIDEO STUDIO that can provide high-quality video recordings without previous A/V experience. Lighting, audio, and video equipment is already in place, so no set up is required.

- High definition camera
- Condenser microphone
- Studio three-point lighting
- White screen
- A projector for content display - *if presenting* content, please bring your own laptop



HOW DOES IT WORK?


 INSERT your flash drive into the one button studio hub. The camera, microphone and studio lights will all automatically turn on.

2. TURN OFF the fluorescent lights in the digital media lab.

3. STAND in the designated spot, marked with black tape on the floor. You will be standing behind the tape.

4. CHECK the MAC to see if you are satisfied with your position on camera.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

5. WHEN READY, press the big, silver button next to you. A countdown will appear on the one button studio screen. Make sure the pointer is on the red button.

6. Once the countdown is complete, recording is in progress and you may BEGIN your video presentation.

7. To STOP RECORDING, press the big, silver button again.

8. WAIT for the One Button Studio software to save your video onto your flash drive. The One Button Studio software will tell you when it is finished.

9. TURN ON the fluorescents.

10. REMOVE your flash drive from the one button studio hub. Your video is now saved as an .mp4 file on your flash drive.
