

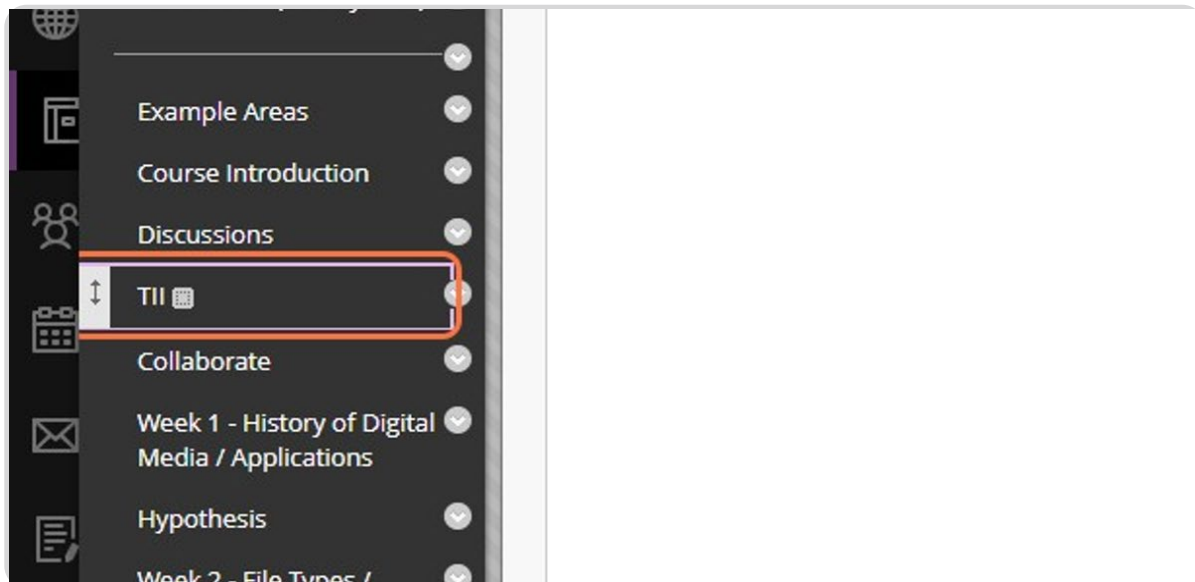


CREATING A TII ASSIGNMENT

Course Menu

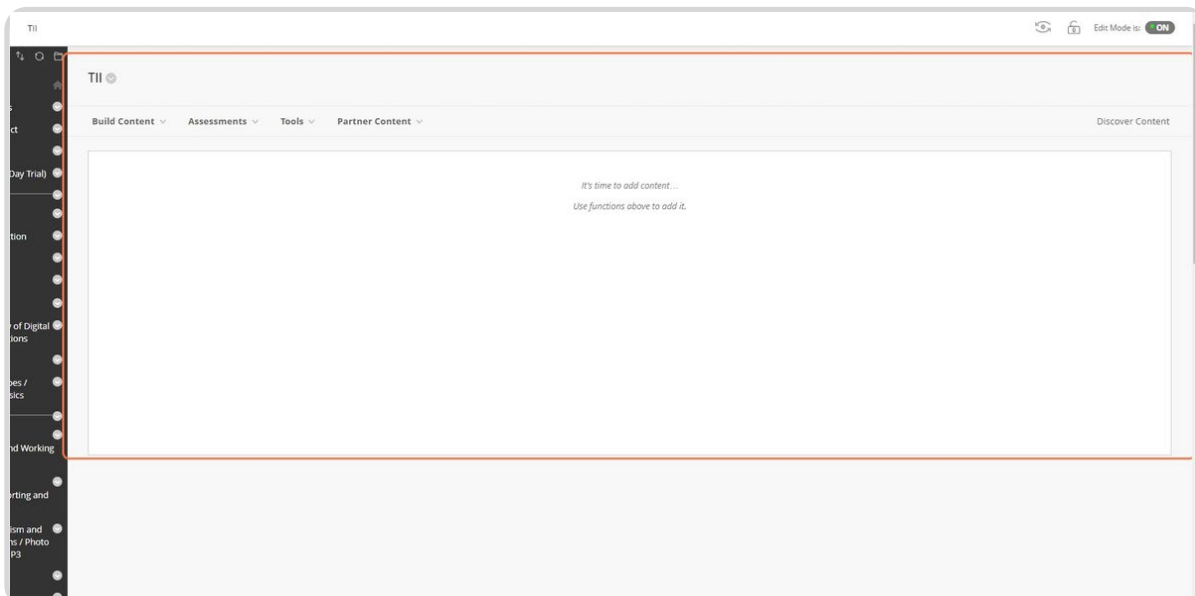
In the course menu, choose the page title where you will place the assignment. This could be a brand new assignment or replacement for a current version.

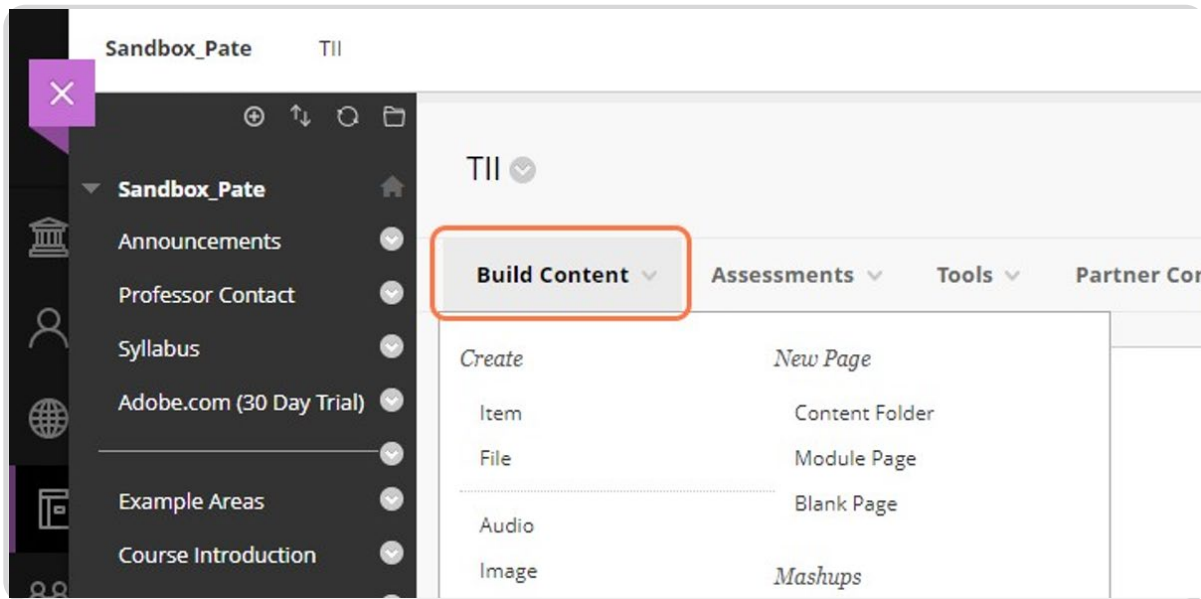
Select the menu item.



Select the Proper Heading

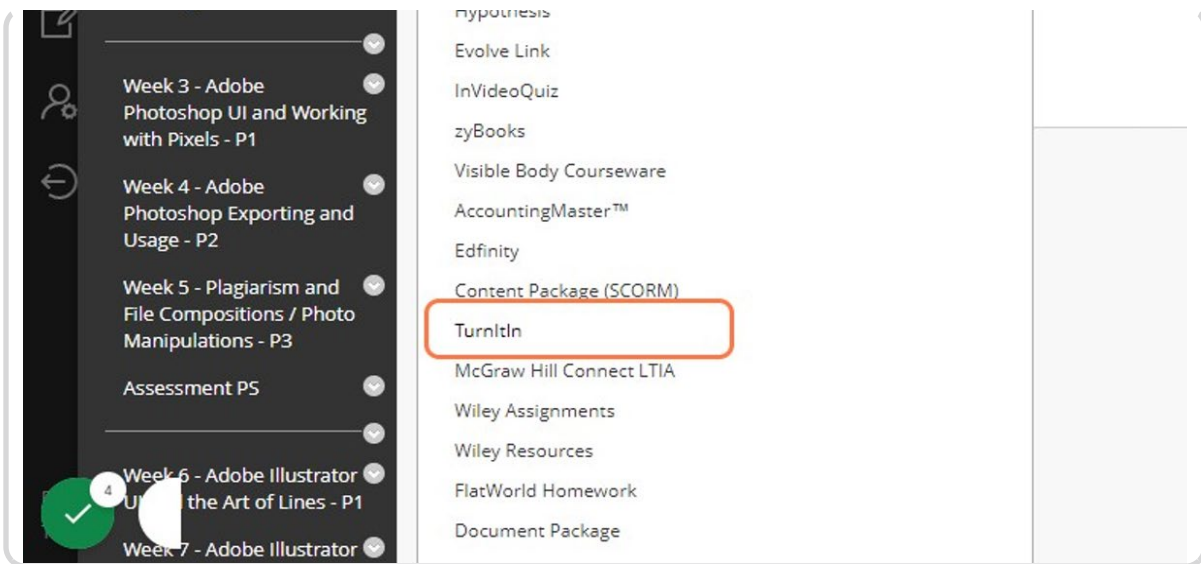
Make sure you are selecting the Build Content menu and not Assessments.

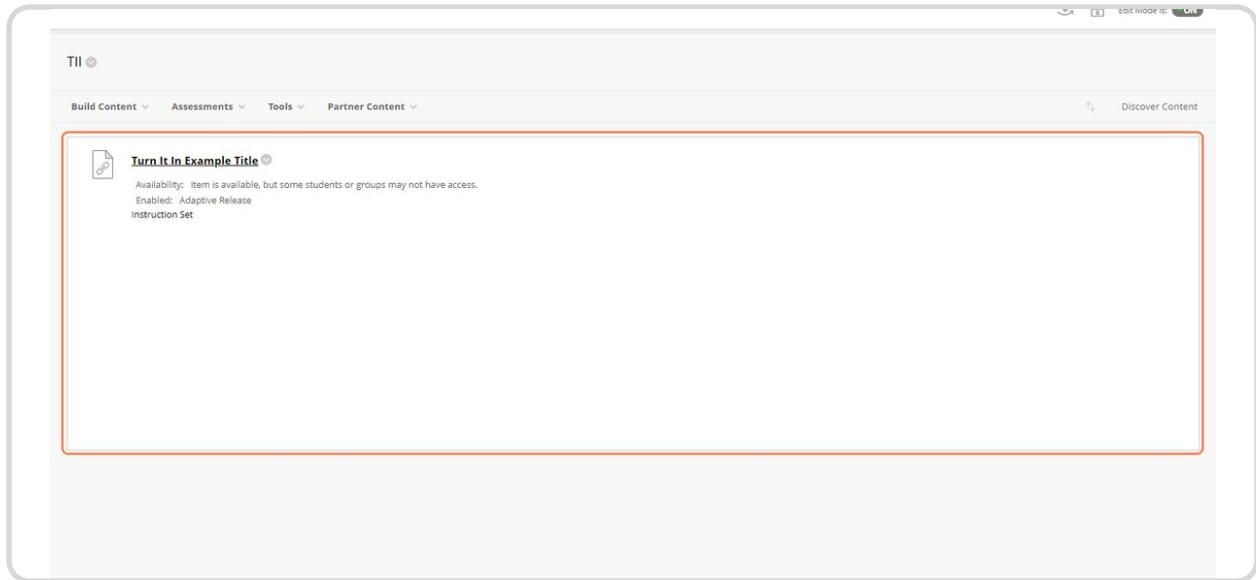
