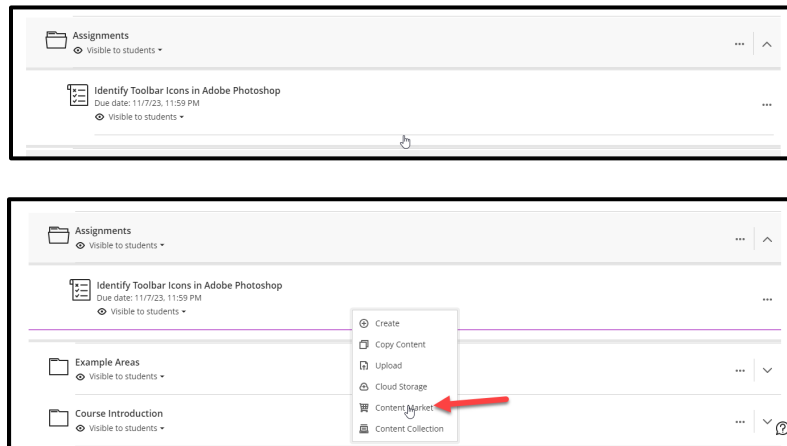


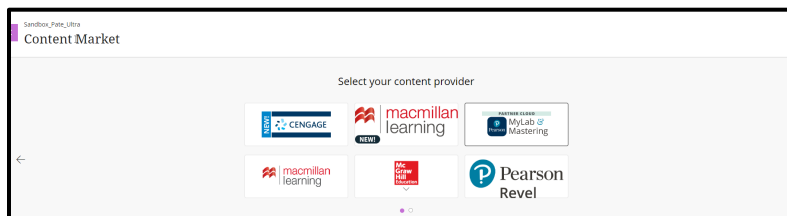


CREATING A TII WRITING ASSIGNMENT

The first step when creating a **TurnItIn** writing assignment is to locate the **Content Area** where you would like to place the assignment. This can be placed in a **Learning Module** or **Folder** but can be moved later once the assignment has been created outside of a module. Either below or above the intended location you will hover your mouse pointer over the **Content Module** until a light purple + sign appears on the left side of the horizontal line. Select the + sign to open your list of options.



Choose **Content Market** from the list of options in the menu.



Once the **Content Market** appears you will scroll down to the **TurnItIn** option. Click on the **TurnItIn** option to open the window to create your assignment.



You will now enter the assignment title, description, points, and dates.

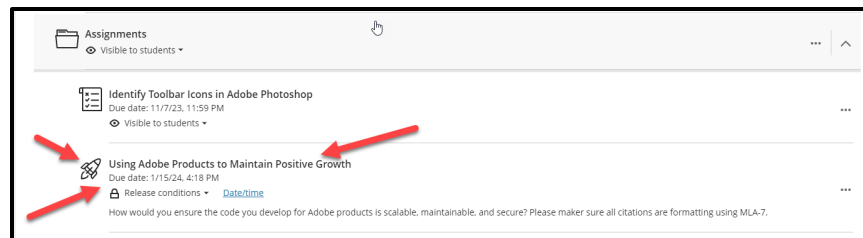
